TOWN OF INTERLACHEN TOWN COUNCIL BUDGET WORKSHOP MINUTES TUESDAY, JULY 19, 2022 – 2:00 P.M. DICKERMAN BUILDING

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairperson Costanzo called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm and dispensed with the formalities.

ROLL CALL:

Council Members present were Chairperson Judi Costanzo, Vice-Chairperson, Carolyn Bennett, Beverly Bakker, Joni Conner, and Carolyn Meadows. Mayor Larsen, Maintenance Supervisor Richard Glover, and Kathy Tillman, from Putnam County Animal Control were present also.

COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON: JUDI COSTANZO

Ms. Tillman stated that the funds the Town donated to Animal Control were used for emergency medical care, spaying and neutering, rabies shots, supplies and equipment.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Discussion and Consideration of the Proposed 2022/2023 Budget for all Departments.

The following was discussed:

- 1) The Tentative Budget Public Hearing was set for September 8, 2022 at 5:05 pm., and the Final Budget Public Hearing was set for September 15, 2022 at 5:05 pm.
- 2) The Roll Back Rate of 7.2553 was approved.
- 3) Employee hourly salaries was increased by \$1.00.
- 4) The Council refused a salary increase.

Discussion and Consideration of Water Ordinance.

- 1) The meter lock fee was increased to \$50.00.
- 2) The meter reinstallation fee was increased to \$150.00,
- 3) Residential connection fee for a ³/₄' meter was increased to \$650.00 and \$900.00 for a 1" meter.
- 4) Commercial connection fee for a 3/4" meter was increased to \$900.00 and \$1,500.00 for a 1' meter.
- 5) A Temp Fee Section was added.
- 6) The increases for installation and testing of back flows were approved as presented.
- 7) Scenario #2 with a residential base rate of \$14.25 and a commercial base rate of \$21.37 was approved.

Discussion and Consideration of the Historical Society Contract.

After discussion on the Historical Society contributing toward utilities, Council Member Conner stated that she will see if other Historical Societies pay for utilities.
