CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Costanzo called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

ROLL CALL

Council Members present were, Chairperson Judi Costanzo, Beverly Bakker, Joni Conner, and Carolyn Meadows. Carolyn Bennett was absent. Mayor Larsen and David Fox, from Fred Fox Enterprises were present also.

COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON: JUDI COSTANZO

Chairperson Costanzo dispensed with the formalities and turned the meeting over to David Fox, from Fred Fox Enterprises, Inc.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Discussion and Consideration of the FFY 2021-2022 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Application.

Mr. Fox stated that this is the second public hearing for the C.D.B.G. Grant.

Service Area #1 consists of replacing the air compressor at the Grassy Lake water Plant, which is over fifty (50) years old, which results in inefficient operation of the hydropneumatic tanks. The new air compressor will allow for improved water plant operations. The proposed budget for Service Area #1 is \$43,000.00.

Service Area #2 consists of installation of an altitude pressure valve and three (3) pressure reducing valves on the elevated storage tank at the Tremont Water Plant to allow for more consistent system pressures. The proposed budget for Service Area #2 is \$124,000.00.

Service Area #3 consists of paving 1,280 LF of Cornell Street, which is an existing dirt road extending from Cline Avenue to Victoria Avenue. This project will address the ongoing runoff and erosion in this area. The proposed budget for this project is \$352,600.00.

Other proposed costs are \$78,400.00 for engineering and \$52,000.00 for administration. The application is for \$650,000.00 with the Town match of \$25,000.00.

Unmet need service areas are the paving of Kindall, and Brandt Streets and Victoria Avenue.

Public Comment

No one from the public were in attendance.

Mr. Fox asked that the record reflect that the newspaper ad was incorrect. Service area #1 should have been listed as Service Area #2, and the amount for Service Area #3 should have been \$352,600.00.

Council Member Bakker moved to approve the FFY 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant Application. Council Member Meadows seconded. Motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote of the Council.
