## Town of Interlachen Chili Cook Off Rules

- Official signed chili cook-off registration forms must be received by March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023, by 1:00 PM.
   On-site registration NOT allowed.
- Each entrant shall be responsible for bringing a chair, as well as the necessary containers and utensils to serve their chili. Bowls, spoons, and napkins for eating will be provided by the Town of Interlachen. Entrants shall bring their own condiments, i.e., onions, sour cream, etc.
- 3. Set Up Time is 11:00AM. You must be ready to serve your heated chili promptly at 12:00PM (Noon). Judging will begin promptly at 12:00PM (Noon).
- 4. Chili must be prepared in advance and brought on site the day of the cook-off. Each cook must prepare 1-2 gallons of chili to be judged by the local celebrity judges.
- The chili container may be a crock pot, steaming roaster, or electric roaster, that is able to maintain the chili at a temperature of 140 degrees or higher. Entrants must bring their own electric extension cord.
   The Town of Interlachen will supply the electricity.
- 6. Entrants cannot sell their chili but may have a clearly marked donation jar.
- 7. NO smoking or vaping will be allowed by people serving food.
