Town of Interlachen Chili Cook Off Rules

- 1. Registration forms must be received by 1:00pm, Friday, March 21. 2025.
- Each entrant shall be responsible for bringing a chair, as well as the necessary containers and utensils to serve their chili. Bowls, spoons, and napkins for eating will be provided by the Town. Entrants shall bring their own condiments, i.e., onions, sour cream, etc. Please limit condiments to three (3).
- 3. Set Up Time is Saturday, March 22nd at 11:00 am. You must be ready to serve your heated chili promptly at 12:00 PM (Noon). Judging will begin promptly at 12:00 PM (Noon).
- 4. Chili must be prepared in advance and brought on-site the day of the cook-off. Each cook must prepare 1-2 gallons (4-8 quarts) of chili to be judged.
- 5. The chili container may be a crock pot, steaming roaster, or electric roaster, that is able to maintain the chili at a temperature of 140 degrees or higher. Entrants must bring their own electric extension cord. The Town of Interlachen will supply the electricity.
- 6. Entrants cannot sell their chili but may have a clearly marked donation jar.
- 7. NO smoking or vaping will be allowed by people serving food.
