

**TOWN OF INTERLACHEN  
FINAL BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES  
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2023 – 5:05 P.M.  
DICKERMAN BUILDING**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairperson Bennett called the Final Budget Public Hearing to order at 5:05 p.m. and dispensed with the formalities.

**ROLL CALL:**

Council members present were Chairperson Carolyn Bennett, Council members Beverly Bakker, Joni Conner, and Carolyn Meadows. Council Member David Yonts was absent, and Mayor Larsen was absent due to illness.

**COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON – CAROLYN BENNETT**

**Publicly announce that the proposed millage rate for FY 2023/2024 of seven point two five five three (7.2553)mills per one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of taxable value is 10.61% higher than the current roll back rate of six point five five nine four (6.5594).**

Chairperson Bennett announced that the proposed millage rate for FY 2023/2024 of seven point two five five three (7.2553) is 10.61% higher than the current roll back rate of six point five five nine four (6.5594), and that the ad valorem taxes are increasing due to the increasing property values.

**Adopt the Final Millage Rate of Seven Point Two Five Five Three (7.2553) for FY 2023/2024.**

Council Member Meadows moved to adopt the final millage for FY 2023/2024 of seven point two five five three (7.2553). Council Member Conner seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote of the Council.

**Resolution 2023-8: Levying of Advalorem Taxes for Town of Interlachen for Fiscal Year 2023/2024.**

By unanimous general consent Resolution 2023-8 was read by title only.

Council Member Conner moved to adopt Resolution 2023-8. Council Member Bakker seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote of the council.
