TOWN COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES
TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2024 - 10:00 A.M.
DICKERMAN BUILDING**

CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Meadows called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer.

ROLL CALL

Council Members present were Chairperson Carolyn Meadows, Vice-Chairperson, Joni Conner, Beverly Bakker, Carolyn Bennett. David Yonts was absent. Mayor Larsen was present.

COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON: CAROLYN MEADOWS

Chairperson Meadows stated that this workshop will cover three different topics. Nothing will be voted on, but they will be narrowing down some things.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION:

Discussion and Consideration of the Caboose.

Maintenance Worker Shelton Griffis gave an overview of replacing and extending the existing stage. There was discussion on using composite instead of wood.

After much discussion on the pros and cons of moving the caboose, extending the stage, or building a pole barn on the Prospect lot.

The Clerk will get a quote to move the caboose and one to build a 16x50' covered pavilion and stage on the Prospect lot.

Discussion and Consideration of Fitness Equipment at Jenkins Park.

The proposed fitness stations will begin in front of Keyser's office and end at the Mayor's house. Equipment will include a Bench Dip, Captain's Chair, Chest Press, Leg Press and Sit-Up stations. The Clerk is to get updated quotes.

Discussion and Consideration of Code Enforcement.

There was some discussion regarding partnering with another municipality for codes enforcement. The Clerk suggested that the Codes Enforcement Officer position be a part-time employee and not a subcontractor. There was some discussion of using Law Enforcement for codes enforcement. A workshop will be set up to discuss this further. Other items that were discussed were fines, eliminating courtesy notices, and removing codes out of the Zoning Ordinance and putting it in the codes' ordinance.
